	Any player who remove their chinstraps before or during fights.	1 game
	Any player who intentionally removes his helmet and intentionally releases his chinstrap to fight and the opposing player doesn't, the former player get an additional two minute minor	1 game
	If the player removes his opponent's helmet or releases the chinstrap before or during a fight	1 game
9.5	#8 LEAVING THE PLAYER'S OR PENALTY BENCH	
9.5(b)	Any Player Identified as First to Leave the Players' Bench During a Fight. If Players of Both Teams Leave Their Respective Players Bench at the Same Time, the First Identifiable Player of Each Team to do so, Shall Incur the Suspension.	2 games
9.5(b)	Any Player Identified as First to Leave the Penalty Bench During a Fight If Players of Both Teams Leave Their Respective Penalty Bench at the Same Time, the First Identifiable Player of Each Team to do so, Shall Incur the Suspension.	3 games
9.5(b)	The Coach of a Team Whose Player is Identified as First to Leave the Players' Bench or Penalty Bench During a Fight or for the Purpose to Start a Fight.	2 games
9.5(c)	The Coach of a Team Whose Player(s) Leave(s) the Players Bench or Penalty Bench During a Fight and is Not Identified As the First to Leave a Bench.	1 game
